

**WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY
NOTICE OF PROPOSED DISCHARGE PERMITS**

The Wyoming Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WYPDES) Program regulates the discharge of pollutants from point sources into surface waters of the state. Operators of point source discharges are required to receive coverage under WYPDES discharge permits. The permits contain limitations and conditions that will ensure that the state's surface water quality standards are protected. Prior to issuing permits, the WYPDES Program prepares a 30-day public notice to inform interested parties of proposed permits and offers an opportunity to provide written comments. The purpose of this notification is to inform the public that the WYPDES Program is proposing the issuance or reissuance of a new set of permits and has prepared a public notice that is available at the DEQ's website (<http://deq.wyoming.gov/wqd/public-notices/water-wypdes/>). The public notice includes copies of currently proposed permits, (including the Lewis Feedlot) relevant application material and clearly defines the deadline and process for providing written comments.
