To ensure all Goshen County residents have the opportunity to review and discuss the newly released Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs), FEMA Region VIII is hosting a Public Flood Risk Open Houses on August 13 at 5:00 PM MT.

Due to COVID-19, this event will be held virtually. FEMA and other state partners will review the mapping changes through an informal presentation before hosting an open Q&A session with experts including insurance specialists, engineers, and members of the mapping team. Residents are strongly encouraged to attend the Open House to learn more about their flood risk, how the new maps may impact flood insurance rates and requirements, and what they can do to help protect themselves and their property from future flooding.
