The Board of County Commissioners of Goshen County, Wyoming met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 am at the Goshen County Courthouse in the Commissioners Chambers with the following members present Chairman John Ellis, Pinky Walter Commissioner and Cindy Kenyon, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board. Vice Chairman Cody Cox was participating by phone. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioner Walter moved to approve the agenda and minutes of the last meeting, seconded and passed.

Sheriff Kory Fleenor presented the Sheriff's report. Commissioner Walter moved to approve the earnings report in the amount of \$1350.00 and the Commissary report, seconded and passed.
