

RESOLUTION 2020-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A CORONAVIRUS RELIEF GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE LOAN AND INVESTMENT BOARD ON BEHALF OF GOSHEN COUNTY, WYOMING

WHEREAS, the Goshen County Board of County Commissioners desires to participate in the CORONAVIRUS RELIEF GRANT program to assist in financing this request; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County of Goshen, State of Wyoming recognizes the need for the request; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Relief Grant program requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the State Loan and Investment Board (SLIB) Rules and Regulations governing the program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and

WHEREAS, if any of the disbursed grant funds are later deemed to not comply with the SLIB criteria or the criteria of the CARES Act, the grant applicant agrees to repay the ineligible grant funds within 15 days of such finding to the Office of State Lands and Investments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Goshen County Board of Commissioners a grant application in the amount of \$3936.00 be submitted to the State Loan and Investment Board for consideration at the next board meeting after the application processing to assist in funding the Coronavirus Relief Grant Program. The project is the Goshen County remote operations equipment project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that John Ellis, Chairman or Cindy Kenyon, County Clerk are hereby designated as the authorized representatives of the Goshen County Board of County Commissioners to act on behalf of the Governing Body on all matters relating to this grant application.
