The Board of County Commissioners of Goshen County, Wyoming met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 am at the Goshen County Courthouse in the Commissioners Chambers with the following members present Chairman John Ellis, Justin Burkart Commissioner and Cindy Kenyon, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board. Commissioner Cox . The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the agenda and the minutes of the last meeting and budget hearing, seconded and passed.

County Sheriff Kory Fleenor presented the monthly earnings report for his department: \$1240.00. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the Sheriff's report, seconded and passed.

County Treasurer Leticia Dominguez presented the monthly report for her department digitally. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded and passed.

County Clerk Cindy Kenyon presented the monthly report for her department. The updated warrant report and payroll liability report was presented for approval. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the warrant report and liability report, seconded and passed.

The Commissioners considered Resolution 2021-04 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS. Commissioner Cox appeared telephonically for approval of the budget. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the Resolution as presented, seconded and passed.

Commissioner Burkart moved to recess as the Board of County Commissioners and convene as the Board of Equalization, seconded and passed. County Assessor Debbi Surratt reported the two tax protests filed have been withdrawn. Commissioner Burkart moved to adjourn the Board of Equalization and reconvene as the Board of County Commissioners, seconded and passed.

The Goshen County Library report was presented by Board Member Larry Curtis. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the library report, seconded and passed.

Paul Novak with the Care Center Joint Powers Board presented an update on the Evergreen Plaza project.

The Commissioners considered the Amendment One extending the end date of the Crisis Response Grant contract between the Wyoming Department of Health and Goshen County. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the amendment to the contract as presented, seconded and passed.
