The Board of County Commissioners of Goshen County, Wyoming met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 am at the Goshen County Courthouse in the Commissioners Chambers with the following members present Chairman John Ellis, Vice Chairman Cody Cox, Commissioner Justin Burkart and Cindy Kenyon, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the revised agenda and the minutes of the last meeting, seconded and passed.

Sheriff Kory Fleenor presented the Sheriff's report. The Sheriff presented a contract to house prisoners for the Town of La Grange. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the contract as presented, seconded and passed. The earnings report for the month of March is \$1390.00. Commissioner Cox moved to accept the Sheriff's Commissary and Earnings reports, seconded and passed.

County Treasurer Leticia Dominguez presented her monthly report. The Treasurer also presented the list of legal depositories for the County. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the depository list as presented, seconded and passed. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded and passed.

Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the contract with Max Masters for GIS services. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the contract as presented.

County Clerk Cindy Kenyon presented the Clerks monthly report. One employee bond was presented. Commissioner Cox moved to approve the employee bond, seconded and passed. Commissioner Cox moved to approve the updated warrant report, seconded and passed. The Clerk's office Earnings report for the month of March is \$17,309.80. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the Clerks earnings report and payroll liabilities report, seconded and passed.

The County Clerk presented Resolution 2022-02 A Resolution Approving the County Election Districts. Commissioner Cox moved too approve Resolution 2022-02 as presented, seconded and passed. A minor change to the employee handbook was presented in Resolution 2022-03 setting shift work employees to one day of sick time per month. Commissioner Cox moved to approve Resolution 2022-03 as presented, seconded and passed. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the Clerks report, seconded and passed.

Library board member Dee Ludwig updated the Commissioners on events at the Library. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the Library report, seconded and passed.

Platte County Representative Jeremy Haroldson thanked Chief Deputy Clerk Mary Feagler and Election Deputy Candace Wardell for their work in redistricting. Representative Haroldson reviewed plans and local funding for a recreation center in Wheatland.

Fort Laramie Mayor Joyce Evans and Colby Sturgeon Yoder Attorney and Lingle Mayor George Siglin and Torrington Mayor Randy Adams spoke regarding the proposed 6<sup>th</sup> penny specific purpose tax. The current estimate of the proposed projects is about \$28,000,000. Chairman Ellis said the Resolution has not been finalized at this time. Commissioner Burkart moved to not support the 6<sup>th</sup> penny specific purpose tax as estimated at \$28,000,000, seconded and passed.

The Commission adjourned at 10:20 am. The next regular meeting will be May 3, 2022 at the usual place and time.
