**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of
GOSHEN COUNTY, WYOMING**

Tuesday July 18, 2023

The Board of County Commissioners of Goshen County, Wyoming met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 am at the Goshen County Courthouse in the Commissioners' Chambers with the following members present, Chairman Michael McNamee, Commissioner Aaron Walsh and Mary Feagler, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board. Vice Chairman Burkart was not present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioner Walsh moved to approve the revised agenda and the minutes from the July 11th meeting, seconded and passed.

Sheriff Kory Fleenor presented the Sheriff's report. The earnings report for the month of June is \$1,880.00 and earnings for the Commissary is \$10,038.92. He presented presented a voucher for radio equipment in the amount of \$12,729.50 for radio equipment. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the Sheriff's report including the Commissary and Earnings reports and voucher, seconded and passed.

County Clerk Mary Feagler presented the updated warrant report, payroll liability voucher, and an employee bond. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the updated vendor report and approve the payroll liability voucher, and the bond, seconded and passed.

Library Board member Ellen Creager updated the Commissioners on events at the Library. She thanked Teresa Haines for serving on the library board for the past 6 years. She will be replaced by Katherine Hawes to serve on the board. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the Library report and appoint Katherine Hawes to the library board, seconded and passed.

Amy Smith, University of Wyoming Extension Educator, Agriculture and Natural Resources and Megan Brittingham, Goshen County 4-H & Extension agent were present and presented the UW and Extension report and Salary Agreement MOU. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the 4-H and Extension report, seconded and passed. The MOU will be reviewed.

Stephanie Lofink Goshen County Fair manager presented her report via e-mail. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the Fair report, seconded and passed.

Thom Bozeman, Emergency manager brought his monthly report. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the EM report, seconded and passed. Fire Warden Bill Law presented a report on the dry weather and recommended a level 1 fire ban. Commissioner Walsh moved to approve the level 1 fire ban, seconded and passed.

The 307 Horse Racing was tabled until the August 1st meeting, Chairman McNamee asked for any person with concerns or comments contact County Clerk Mary Feagler to be placed on the agenda for the August 1st meeting.

Debbi Surrat was added to the agenda to discuss an employee item. The meeting went into executive session.

Tony Curcio from Western Proppants was present he works for Dietzler Company. They produce frack sand. Mr. Curcio gave information on what the company does.

Doug Butler was to appear to discuss a speed limit issue but wasn't able to attend.
