

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of  
GOSHEN COUNTY, WYOMING

Tuesday Oct 17, 2023

The Board of County Commissioners of Goshen County, Wyoming met in regular session on the above date at 9:00 am at the Goshen County Courthouse in the Commissioners’ Chambers with the following members present, Chairman Michael McNamee, Vice Chairman Justin Burkart, Commissioner Aaron Walsh and Mary Feagler, County Clerk and Clerk of the Board. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the revised agenda and the minutes from the October 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting, seconded and passed.

Sheriff Kory Fleenor presented the Sheriff’s report. The earnings report for the month of September is \$2,165.00 and balance for the Commissary is \$5,636.63. He mentioned the camera’s that will be purchased for the vehicles. They will be paid for in April and will require an amendment to the budget. Commissioner Walsh moved to approve purchase of the vehicle cameras, seconded and passed. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the Sheriff’s report including the Commissary and Earnings reports, seconded and passed.

County Treasurer Leticia Dominguez presented her report and Irrigation Contracts for a signature. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the report, seconded and passed.

County Clerk Mary Feagler presented the updated warrant report, the payroll liability voucher and a voucher for Yoder Fire District for the pass-through funds. Commissioner Burkart moved to accept the updated vendor report, approve the payroll liability voucher, and the Fire District pass-through voucher, seconded and passed.

Library Board member Michelle Traher reported for the library. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the Library report, seconded and passed.

Amy Smith, Ag and Natural Resource Extension Educator reported for the Extension office. She reported on the Ag Day they hosted for the 4<sup>th</sup> graders of Goshen County. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the Extension report, seconded and passed.

Stephanie Lofink Goshen County Fair manager was not able to report in person she reported by e-mail.

Public Health nurse Melissa Johnson presented the Public Health report. Interim Public Health Nurse Manager Kim Proffit was available by phone to report. A Nurse Manager has been hired and she will start October 31<sup>st</sup>. Kim spoke on fall illnesses and immunizations. Commissioner Burkart moved to approve the purchase of RSV and Covid vaccine, seconded and passed. Commissioner Walsh moved to accept the Public Health report, seconded and passed.

County Assessor Debbi Surratt reported and presented reduction orders and rebate orders totaling \$1,850.93. Commissioner Walsh moved to approve the reduction and rebate orders, seconded and passed.

The Commissioners interviewed Michael Ridenour for the County Planning Board. They will have one more interview at a later date.

Doug Butler and Matthew Cearns presented an Application for Industrial Development Revenue Bond Financing. It will be reviewed and addressed again at a later date.

The transfer of Liquor License from BZ Hospitality, dba The Bucking Horse Steak House to 307 Horse Racing Inc. hearing for November 1 transfer was presented. Commissioner Walsh moved to approve the transfer of the liquor license pending the state liquor division approval, seconded and passed.

Recess for executive session at 10:40 back in session 10:47.

Andy Barnett from the northern part of the county came for public comment on the road issues.

The Commission adjourned at 11:15 am. The next regular meeting will be October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023 at the usual place and time. Per Wyo.
